I give permission for _____ (student name) to participate in the T-Mobile Project 10Million (the Project). The Project provides hotspot devices and monthly data plans (a cost shared by The Project and DPS), enabling internet access to students without current in-home connectivity.

I certify that my student does not have internet access in the home, and that the Project will be the sole source of my student's in-home internet access. A lack of home internet access means no internet access in the home. Personal mobile devices are not considered home internet access.

I understand that my student will receive a device along with access to the internet for academic purposes. I understand that T-Mobile, the Project and/or Denver Public Schools may collect data concerning my student and/or monitor my student's usage of any device provided through the Project. I understand that T-Mobile's use of my student's personal information is governed by the Project 10Million Privacy Policy (<https://www.t-mobile.com/privacy-center/our-practices/project-10-million-privacy-policy>). I understand that my student must comply with the *MyTech Devices and Network Resources Agreement*. I further understand that the device(s) supplied to my Student may be collected, the internet services may be suspended, or the Project as a whole may be suspended at any time with or without notice and that neither T-Mobile nor Denver Public Schools will have any continuing obligation to provide devices, internet service or other benefits of the Project on an ongoing basis. I understand that if this device is no longer required (e.g. in the event that permanent home internet access is installed or the student leaves the district) that I am responsible for returning the device and that if I do not return the device, I may be invoiced for the missing device.

I waive any and all claims against T-Mobile; Denver Public Schools; or its elected board members, employees, agents and contractors (collectively, the Project Providers) related to the T-Mobile Project 10Million. My waiver includes, but is not limited to, any claims related to the Project Providers' data collection and device usage monitoring practices; the Project Providers' use of my student's personal information gathered via the Project, whether or not stored on devices supplied through the Project; unauthorized third party access, alteration or theft of my student's information, files or programs stored on any devices supplied through the Project; my student's ability or inability to access particular content through any devices supplied through the Project; my student's ability or inability to access content at particular speeds (e.g., 4G).

COPPA Notice Addendum

T-Mobile is providing Customer with direct notice of its data collection, use and disclosure practices set forth below that relate to the Service(s). Customer has read this notice, consents on behalf of parents and guardians of children under 13 to the collection, use and disclosure practices described below, and authorizes T-Mobile to engage in such practices.

Direct Notice of T-Mobile's Data Collection, Use, and Disclosure Practices

We need your consent to collect personal information from your child(ren) in connection with the Project 10Million service. We will not collect, use, or disclose any personal information from children under 13 if you do not provide such consent. This privacy notice describes the personal information we collect and how we use it. The Federal Trade Commission has stated that a district or school may consent to such data collection, use, and disclosure on behalf of the parent or guardian to the extent such data collection, use, and disclosure is to provide services solely for the benefit of the school.

T-Mobile intends to collect the following personal information from your child(ren):

- **Data Usage:** T-Mobile tracks quantity of broadband internet data usage to have that usage total counted against the 100 GB per year of free broadband internet access. As part of delivering this service, T-Mobile also receives the IP address associated with the websites visited.
- **Unique identifiers:** T-Mobile collects a device and network identifier to authenticate the device on our network and provide the service.

T-Mobile uses this personal information only to provide internet connectivity and perform internal analytics. T-Mobile may disclose this personal information to its service providers for assistance in delivering the service, and they must treat this information as confidential and use it only for the purposes for which T-Mobile engaged them. T-Mobile will not disclose information that may be associated with your child to any other entities.

Please be advised that T-Mobile provides connectivity to the general internet through the Project 10Million service. That connectivity allows children to access websites that may involve data collection by third parties. T-Mobile is not responsible for the data collection activities of these third parties and you should carefully monitor your child's use of the service.
